Dr. Roy was born in 1924. He has a bachelor's and master's degree from Patna University and a Ph.D. from Penn State University. He spent 65 years at Penn State. From a graduate student to a professor, and in 1962

established a material research laboratory. The laboratory is considered the world's No. 1 material research laboratory by the American Scientific Information Association for its well-known scientists.

Dr. Roy was the first Indian to be elected to the US National Academy of Engineering, and the first to become a member of National Academy of Science and Engineering in Japan, Switzerland, India and Russia. These are truly rare and unique achievements. As one of the most outstanding scientists today, he has been awarded numerous national and international awards. Including Japan's equivalent of an American "Chivalry" Sublime Honor Awards.

Not only does he hold a top position in materials science, he has a wide range of interests in the sciences. He contributed to government science policies, radioactive waste management, sexual ethics, religion, and more importantly, holistic treatment (alternative medicine). In England he was chosen as lecturer of the "Hibbert Lecture" (a famous

Listed lectures). He is a member of the Friends of Health Foundation and a founding member of the Universe Active Energy Foundation and lifetime advisor. His contributions to medicine and holistic treatment, as well as his contributions to material science and physics, are equally recognized by the world. He has collaborated with many (including the famous Dr. Larry Dossey) leading scientists and scholars in alternative medicine research in the United States.
